A Sample Transcript with CLEP Credits

The transcript below is designed to show how CLEP credits can be incorporated into the typical high school transcript for the accelerated student. The sample shows a pathway to get 50+ CLEP credits for the super-motivated student. Obviously, students can study for fewer credits or switch to community college courses in the 11th or 12th grades.

The Honors Designation

On the sample, any course that could be supported by a CLEP exam was designated as "honors" except for Algebra which I preferred to call Advanced Algebra. My students took Algebra I in the 8th grade and Algebra II in the 9th grade and then took the College Algebra CLEP. I did not weight my students' grades. You can do that if necessary.

CLEP List on Page 2 of Transcript

To showcase the CLEP credits earned, I included them in separate table on page 2 of the transcript. This format was acceptable to the colleges my kids applied to.

8th Grade Credits on the Transcript

Homeschoolers, who often work at multiple grade levels each year, are challenged to place their courses into transcript blocks that work for traditional students but not for them. The problem is particularly noteworthy when considering 8th grade courses. Many homeschoolers take high school courses in the 8th grade and want to include them on the high school transcript. There are several ways to justify adding them, and I have done so with my children. Remember, we are not bound by the same constraints.

There's an advantage to adding *four* 8th grade credits to the high school transcript in the 9th grade tile. This allows college-bound students who need 7 credits a year to take a 6-credit load each year. The "lighter" course load helps students who are studying college level material. It also helps students who want to graduate early achieve a 22-credit transcript sooner. This will hopefully make sense when you look at the sample.

How to Decode the Sample Transcript

The sample transcript places traditional courses in the traditional slots. But the colors indicate when your student will actually take the courses. Green courses are taken in the 8th grade; purple courses are taken in the 9th grade; white courses are taken in the 10th grade; orange courses are taken in the 11th grade; yellow courses are taken in the 12th grade.

If you plan to adapt this format for your student, please don't include the info in parentheses or the color-coding. That information is there to help clarify matters.
